Origin

Dog descends from wolf. He was human's first domestic animal. Originally he helps hunting and protects the nomad camps. After human's settlement his new job stays protection of the flocks against thieves and predators. Diverging duties of the particular dog is enforcing the deviation of the type of dog. The breeding of particular dog-races has developed later on.


